Veterinary Sciences (ISSN 2306-7381, <https://www.mdpi.com/journal/vetsci>) has been accepted for inclusion in Science Citation Index Expanded (SCIE) in the Web of Science Core Collection. And will receive its First Impact Factor in June 2021 (JCR - Clarivate Analytics). CiteScore 2019 (Scopus data): 2.2, which equals rank 35/178 in the 'General Veterinary' category.

The Article Processing Charges (APC) for accepted papers are CHF 1600.
